Beginning April 5th, all Wisconsin residents over the age of 16 will be eligible for the vaccine. This is great news and from a process stand point will help our planning. We want to remind everyone that although it is open to everyone, there is still limited supply of vaccine which means that it will take time to get everyone vaccinated that would like it.

Public Health has received confirmation of our vaccine allocations for next week and will again receive both the Pfizer and Johnson and Johnson vaccines. On site, we will try to offer a choice of brands as long as supplies lasts. We will make every effort to accommodate your preferences, however this is based on availability of vaccine. If your preferred vaccine is not available, you will have the option to decline and reschedule to the next available clinic. Pfizer is the only vaccine currently approved for age 16 and up. All minors under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult at the clinic. We want to be clear that both types are safe and effective, and we believe people should take which ever brand they are able to get.

At this point, our allotment is greater on April 7th than appointments we have scheduled. As a result, we are opening up additional appointments through our on-line scheduling system for that date. Our county website (www.doorcounty.gov) and COVID-19 page are available for translation to your language of choice. To translate, click on the link in the lower right-hand corner and select language. Our online scheduling system does not have a language option at this time. However, we are able to serve our non-English speaking consumers by utilizing a language-line service when contacted by phone.

To help our clinic run smoothly, we do have one request. Please do not arrive early for your appointment. We have become very efficient in our process and our clinic is scheduled to accommodate a maximum number of appointments per hour, arriving early interferes with the flow and may cause longer wait times.
